Product: CR 106

### **Description:**

CR 106 is a low viscous reactive diluent modified epoxy resin based on bisphenol - A. Due to low viscosity it is capable of high filler loading and excellent wetting property. It can be cured with various hardeners like polyamidoamide, phenalkamines, aliphatic amines, cycloaliphatic amines, and adducts. The appropriately cured material is able to provide good combination physical and mechanical properties.

### Packaging:

CR 106 is available in 200 kg HDPE drums. Other packing may be considered on request.

### **Storage and Handling:**

CR 106 should be stored in a cool and dry place, preferably in a sealed container and should not be exposed to direct sunlight. This product has a shelf life of 2 years, if stored in its original container between 18°C and 25°C away from humidity and excessive heat. Please refer to the Safety Data Sheet (SDS) for detailed instructions on storage and handling.

### Safety:

Wear personal protective equipment (PPE). Avoid contact with the eyes and skin. In case of direct contact and irritation, the resin should be washed off immediately with soap and warm water. Avoid breathing vapours, mist or gas. Please refer to the SDS for detailed safety instructions.

#### **Spills and Disposal:**
